

Tension Trouble

When a "bird's nest" of thread appears either on top of or underneath your fabric, the likely culprit is your upper



thread tension. If loops appear on the underside of the fabric, the upper thread tension may be too loose. If knots appear on top of the fabric, the upper tension may be too tight.
