
Favorite Childhood Doll Form

to learn how to make your quilts even better and to get positive strokes for the things you do well in your quilts.

2015 Ohio State Fair – Enter Your Quilt(s)!

This year the Ohio State Fair has made the entry process and entry categories for quilts easier. I hope many of you will take advantage of this venue to display your quilts and maybe earn some ribbons and prize money. Also encourage any young quilters you know to enter in the youth category, ages 11-17.

Go to the Printer friendly Contestant Entry Form when you are ready to enter your quilt(s)

Some points to remember:

- 1. Entry deadline is June 20, 2015. Delivery dates are July 17 & 18, 2015.
- 2. Be sure to measure your quilt to match the correct entry category. It will be disqualified if entered in the wrong category.
- 3. Please read carefully the hanging sleeve requirements.
- 4. You may enter up to 2 items per category. Items must have been completed in the past 2 years and this must be the first time it has exhibited at the State Fair.
- Since you will now have a label on your quilt@, you must cover your name for the judging process.
 (An easy way to do this is to use Roxanne's Glue-Baste-It temporary water dissolvable glue and a piece of selvage edge scrap.)
- 6. First time entrants have a special award and the quilt may now be entered in any category.

Some notable changes from previous years:

- 1. There are fewer categories and the size requirements are listed right with the category line.
- The exhibit has been moved to the Rhodes Center (because the DiSalle building is being torn down.)
- 3. Award money has been increased in many categories.
- 4. Drop off days are Friday evening & Saturday only. (No Sunday this year.)
- 5. Wall hangings no longer require their own hanging rod. These are now provided by the fair.
- 6. First-time entrants are no longer limited to bed size quilts. You must note that you are entering this quilt class for the first time on the quilt description form to qualify.
