#### Quilters Hall of Fame, Marion, Indiana

This year's inductee is Xenia Cord. She was partner and producer of Quilt America, a national quilt convention held in Indianapolis for eleven years. She is a past president and board member of AQSG, a past board member of The Quilters Hall of Fame and an advisory board member of the International Quilt Study Center and Museum. She is the founder of Midwest Fabric Study Group and is known within the group as a guiding leader and mentor. Her research and diligence in identifying fabrics and styles of the past has enhanced our quilt heritage and encouraged others in their research.

#### Missouri Star Quilt Company, Hamilton, Missouri

We drove this in two days and stayed in Cameron, MO. Missouri Star is a fun place, but be prepared...there is so much fabric that if you don't have a project in mind...you could end up with a load of fabrics! 


