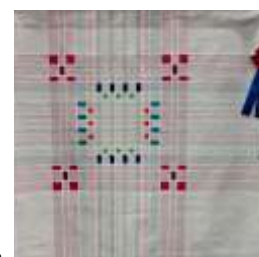

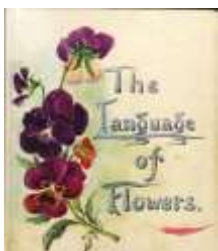


is a regular blog writer of "The (not so) Dramatic Life." Cassandra will discuss her journey in the quilt world and bring a selection of her quilts.

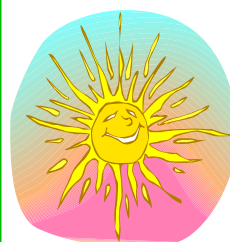

Remember, we have no "sewing wenchies" this time! We each need to do our own ironing and trimming.
