WQG Bus Trip to Original Sewing & Quilt EXPO

Cleveland - Friday, April 3, 2020 7:30am - 8:00pm

The Original Sewing & Quilt EXPO is held in several cities across the country every year. It is a place to find the latest techniques and products (AKA Shopping!), learn new skills with cutting-edge education (LOTS of classes), and experience displays and galleries of creativity. Check the website for full descriptions of events, vendors, demos:

We will be traveling by Fun Bus to the IX Center in Cleveland to attend this year's show! Your fee of \$50 will include: Round-trip transportation by motor coach (includes driver gratuity), admission to the EXPO, snacks on the bus, and a commemorative shopping bag. You will be responsible for your own meals (food vendors will be available as the IX Center prohibits bringing in outside food and beverages), class fees, and shopping.

Check out the schedule of classes online at www.sewingexpo.com. You may register in advance for classes (yes, they DO fill up). Just make sure they begin after 10am and end by 6pm. The schedule is extensive and the expo lasts 3 days, so read the descriptions and times carefully. There is an additional charge for classes - \$23/class. Sewing machines ARE provided, but you'll need to pack any additional sewing supplies/notions.

As an incentive, you can save \$2.50 by registering and paying for the trip at the January meeting or by January 31st. We've invited the Sunbury Piece Corps to join us as well. I'd like to see us fill a 54-passenger bus, so we will open the trip up to outside friends beginning in February.
