




**The Art of Quilting** honors America's contemporary art quilters by visiting art quilt exhibitions across the country and through personal interviews with nationally and internationally noted fabric artists.

The program highlights the quilts and artists of Quilt National – a bienniel show held for nearly 30 years at the Dairy Barn in Athens, Ohio – the premier exhibition of contemporary art quilts in the country.
