

June 24, 2008 Nancy Jo Thompson President-of-the-Month Marilyn Doheny's Wedge Ruler Demo



This is the 9° circle wedge ruler that you can use with your strata (strip sets) to create those fabulous spirals that look so difficult! You can also use this to create wedge-pieced quilts similar to a Dresden plate. Nancy Jo Thompson will show us some of the ways she has utilized this great tool. If you've used this and have a finished piece—bring it for show 'n tell!

WQG Sesquicentennial Celebration Quilt Show

We've received official confirmation from the Sesquicentennial Celebration Comm. that we can indeed charge for our ornaments. So Ann will be contacting all who signed up to help make things that fly - birds, butterflies & dragonflies. Please give us your talents for her sew-ins! Fall Retreat News!!




