Quilter's Green Tips

Recommended by Shannon Bartlett:



Use a thin plastic sheet or a piece of Plexiglas (leftovers from an old or broken picture frame would work great!) Instead of sketching with a pencil, use a dry-erase marker. Lay the plastic over your blocks and draw the quilting designs on the plastic. If you don't like them, wipe them off and try something different until you find the one you like. If you want to keep this design for future reference, you can trace it onto tracing paper. Then simply erase the design when you are done and use the plastic sheet again on your next project.
