QUILT SHOW BOUTIQUE

I received 6 exquisite purses at the May meeting. If anyone still wishes to make a purse, either for an adult or a child, your efforts will be most appreciated.

At the June meeting I shall be collecting tote bags or reusable grocery sacks that you have made. Please refer to the Links on our web site for suggestions and instruction.

In July I will be collecting fabric wine coasters. Construction is simple: Cut three 5" squares, either 3 different fabrics, or one different and two the same. One square will be the back. Press the two remaining contrasting fabric squares in half, **WRONG** sides together. Lay the rectangles over the **WRONG** side of the back, and overlap like you were folding a cardboard carton closed. Secure with pins, sew a quarter-inch seam allowance around the perimeter and turn right side out. Viola! Please make sets of four coasters to a set.
