Each year on August 22, pecan lovers across the country participate in National Pecan Torte Day. A torte is a rich

dessert filled with whipped cream, buttercream, mousse, jam, fruits or nuts. The baker will often glaze and garnish the torte once it is cooled. Generally made with little to no flour, tortes use ground nuts or breadcrumbs, along with sugar, eggs and flavorings instead.

The pecan tree is the only nut tree native to North America.

This fun challenge involves selecting three colors based on your initials from Crayola crayons. Add to that one neutral color (white, beige, gray or black) to create an item of choice; mini guilt, wall hang-

ing, mug rug, full quilt or any item you choose. Hmm, maybe its a fancy pin cushion or mini basket or book cover!

The best way to get a list of all color names is from Wikipedia. Search on Crayola Crayon colors and select Wikipedia. A list of more than 100 crayons will appear with the actual color or you just may want to choose your colors from a box of crayons!

A NEW HOME FOR HISTORY

From mid-April to the first SOUTHEAST OHIO of September, the new HISTORY CENTER Southeast Ohio History Center in Athens, Ohio will be featuring an antique and contemporary quilt exhibit called, Quilts and Stories: WWI to WWII. This exhibit is part of the grand opening of the history center.

In January 2016, the Athens Historical Society purchased the century old First Christian church building at 24 West State Street, Athens. The building, listed on the National Registry of Historic Places offers two large exhibit areas and an opportunity to acquire and properly store collections from the region.

The guilts tell the story of American life between two world wars, the first couple decades for a large membership. There will be a WWI exhibit entering the center with several guilts to help tell story. As viewers progress through the exhibit, guilts and textiles will take you on a journey into the past.

A special feature will be an opportunity to vote for a favorite contemporary Dresden Plate design that was a challenge event for several guilds in the area.
