Fun With Fabric - Don't Pass It Up Challenge (Lisa Smith)

It's not too late to participate. If you missed the April WQG meeting or forgot your fat quarters you can still enter the challenge. Just bring 4 FQs and see Lisa Smith to exchange them. FQs can be different or from the same fabric. Just be sure that fabric is cut into FQs (at least 18" x 22"). As always, FQs should be quilt shop quality. Don't agonize over your selection...just pull something from your stash. The challenge is to make a quilt of any size using visible pieces of the FQs you receive. All 2018 challenges should include use of a plaid fabric somewhere in your piece.

Fun With Fabric - "Rust"ic Surface Design Challenge (Shannon Bartlett)

Are you interested in surface design techniques but don't know where to start? Rusting fabric is an easy and fun way to dabble in surface design. All you need is water, vinegar, steel wool, and salt. Upcoming Workshops!

The next guild workshop is scheduled for Saturday, June 30 at the Westerville Sew and Save (5900 Westerville Rd. in Westerville) and will be all about binding - regular and bias binding, making continuous strips, and attaching and joining the ends to finish. Offered by Janice Baer and Emerald McClaugherty, the class will run from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. There is no charge for the class, but a book must be purchased for \$15. Your sewing machine and basic sewing supplies will be needed.

On Saturday, July 28, Rita Fishel of Creations Sew Clever in Chillicothe will offer an all-day "mystery" quilt workshop. The class will be held at The Gathering Place, 74 N. State Street in Westerville from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The cost for this workshop is \$130 and includes an \$85.95 kit fee for a 60" x 72" quilt top in your choice of

colors. Lunch will be provided. Supplies needed include: your sewing machine, neutral thread with a couple of filled bobbins, rotary cutter, mat and ruler, a seam ripper and thread nips or scissors. We will also need a couple of "wenches" who will offer assistance with pressing and ripping! Wenches will be given a free pattern for their time and efforts, and will not pay for the class.

Our final scheduled workshop of 2018 is with Ali Strebel of Dayton. Ali will be teaching a wool pincushion which includes needle felting. The kit fee of \$30 will include all wool, as well as a small tin tray made especially for this project. The total fee for this workshop is \$81 and will include lunch. We will again be meeting at The Gathering Place, 74 N. State Street in Westerville on Saturday, September 22 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. A basic hand sewing kit will be needed. Ali will also be bringing items to sell and we will open the sale to all guild members beginning at 2:30 p.m.

Registrations for all three workshops will be taken at the May meeting. Non-refundable payment is due at the time of sign-up.



Tickets for the Serendipity Raffle Basket will be on sale at the beginning of the meeting and during the meeting. The basket will contain assorted s Serendipity themed treats. The drawing will be at the end of the

meeting. Tickets are \$1 or 6 for \$5.
