

The Ribbon was the world's largest art project for Peace when it wrapped all of official Washington, DC from the Pentagon to the White House in 1985 for the 40th anniversary of the bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Sherry Lee Lowe was the Illinois coordinator for the event. She will display some of the 1500 Ribbons (Yard long fabric panels from individuals and groups) she received from all over the state and carried along with volunteers to the event for August 4th, 1985.

Join us for this fascinating presentation of dedication and completion of a project by people with a cause. There will be examples of the ribbons shown.

FWF Challenges 2019

Remember the Ladies! - Due March 26, 2019 In honor of National Women's History Month, we challenge you to make a quilt (or quilted object) of any size that depicts a favorite female. This can be a real person, a fictional hero, or a quilt block inspired or named for woman.

June 25 — Opposites Attract Challenge due

The 2019 Color Challenge will put you in touch with your inner color wheel. Participants will roll the dice to determine their "color." The challenge is to make a quilt using that color and it's complimentary color (opposite colors on the color wheel). Quilts can be any size but should feature the complementary colors designated by your roll of the dice.

June Workshop — Labyrinth Walk

We have 3 paid registrations for each day, so there are only 5 spots left for each session.



Sign up at the March meeting for the Wednesday, June 5, from 10:30am-4:30pm or Wednesday, June 12 from 12:00 - 6:00pm. Susan Buttermore, Quilting instructor at Jo-Ann's Easton, will be the instructor for this workshop. The location is St. Paul Lutheran Church, 4686 East Walnut, Westerville. We have a 16 student maximum, 8 per session.

The cost for the workshop will be \$65-70, which includes lunch and a pattern. We are asking everyone to reserve their spot with a \$20 minimum deposit. We want to order patterns for everyone and distribute them at the April meeting. Full payment is needed by May 10 (by mail) or April 23 (if you want to save a stamp). Please make checks out to "Westerville Quilt Guild." If something happens, and you need to cancel, please try to find a person to take your spot. We will refund the workshop cost, minus the cost of the pattern (which you can keep).

You will choose and purchase your own fabrics. Susan will provide us with a supply list and color suggestions. Please have all fabric cut and prepped before your workshop.
