June Workshop — Labyrinth Walk

You will choose and purchase your own fabrics. Susan will provide us with a supply list and color suggestions. Please have all fabric cut and prepped before your workshop. At the minimum, you'll need fabric cut to complete the 2 blocks that are used throughout the guilt.
