The guild is going to have a ZOOM meeting on January26th at 6:30 pm. The link to join the meeting will be emailed to you on Friday, January 22nd.

Here are some helpful hints....

It helps if you have a little knowledge on how zoom works. This is the link for the instructions on joining a test meeting. You are the only one in the "meeting" but you can see how it works. You can find where the buttons are to: mute/unmute mic, start/stop video (camera), participant list, chat, leave meeting Depending on if you are using a phone, laptop or PC, the buttons are in different locations on the screen.

Or you can visit <u>http://zoom.us/test</u> to join a test meeting, then follow the instructions to test your video or audio.

You will be prompted to download ZOOM app the first time that you start ZOOM on your device.

You will go to a "waiting room" and be admitted into the meeting once the host has started the meeting. You will see a picture of a flower while you are in the "waiting room".

Once you are in the meeting you will see yourself and several others depending on how many are in the meeting and what you "view" settings are. To change your view read these instructions, instructions for Android or iPad are at the bottom of this page:
