Preview for 2023:

Short Story Mystery Quilt: this one is quick and easy. There are many layout options and it is easy to expand the size if you want something larger than the 48"x48" mystery pattern.

Monthly block challenge. We will assign a block, size, and color theme each month. Once we have accumulated some blocks there will be sew-ins scheduled to turn the blocks into quilt tops for Flying Horse Farms.

Horsing Around Charity Quilt Challenge - make a quilt and/or a pillowcase for Flying Horse Farms. Requirements will be given out at the January meeting and we hope to have kits available.

UFO Challenge. For every UFO completed and shown at WQG Meetings, you will get an entry ticket for a quarterly drawing for a "major award". Drawings will be held in March, June, September and Nov/Dec.

Pin Up Girls Challenge. We all have collected enamel pins from quilt shows, vendors, guilds, etc. This challenge is to get those pins out of the drawer of your sewing cabinet and put them on display. This could be a garment (hat or sash), a wall hanging, a tote, etc.

Hobbs Charity Batting Program

Please save UPC labels from Hobbs Batting so we can join the Hobbs Charity Batting Program (<https://www.hobbsbatting.com/resources/for-quilters/giving-back/>). We hope to get enough labels to provide batting for the Flying Horse Farm quilts.

The Hobbs Charity Batting Program provides batting at discounted prices:

The 80/20 Cotton/Poly Blend is on a 96" x 30 yd. roll and is priced at \$92.35 +shipping

The 100% Polyester batting is on a 96" x 30 yd. roll and is priced at \$32.73 +shipping

Each form submitted requires 5 UPC labels from packages of Hobbs batting. Guilds are encouraged to have members save all of their Hobbs packaged product labels and submit them to the guild chair to enable the guild to more quickly 'earn' discounted batting.

We can submit a request for 2 rolls (10 upc codes) with one form.



Ohio Quilts Grant

A grant request has been presented to Ohio Quilts. If we receive the grant (up to \$500), we will use the money

for batting, backing, quilting services or rental space for the Flying Horse Farms quilt project. The grant will also cover materials for pillowcases. Shannon Bartlett submitted the grant proposal and any money received will be handled and tracked through the guild treasurer/account.
