

Seamless Quilt Binding Tutorial by Dena Crain

This technique by former Ohioan Dena Crain from Nairobi, Kenya was taught at the NQA show in May in her "Fuss-Free and Seamless Bindings" workshop. Shannon Bartlett and I took this class



and I was very excited to see this method demonstrated, as well as several others. I asked Dena if this technique, which when done correctly results in practically perfect mitered corners on the binding, could be used on even a pieced binding in order to get the corners so nice. Dena was surprised but told me that of course it could be...all it takes is a complete length of binding...pieced or not pieced!

So check out her web site, www.denacrain.com and the free tutorial for this technique if you are intrigued. There are several other free tutorials available along with loads of information about her art quilting, workshops, and Africa available on her web site too!

Dena is also working on a new online school **QuiltingOnline** to replace Quilt University. She is starting this with a variety of her online workshops that will be available soon. See her web site for more information.
