

A real pain in the neck/shoulders/back may be due to our cutting station, sewing chair, or machine table! By implementing Barb's tips, quality will certainly improve when our work space is properly set up and the right tools are used.

Ergonomics (or human factors) is the scientific discipline concerned with the understanding of interactions among humans and other elements of a system, and the profession that applies theory, principles, data and methods to design in order to optimize human well-being and overall system performance.
