The Fallen Fifteen, founded in 2014 as a central Ohio nonprofit organization, provides outreach to soldiers from the



Iraq and Afghanistan wars. Whether the soldier is returning home or transitioning out of the service, Fallen Fifteen programs and events are designed to re-establish bonds and build camaraderie.

For the organization's upcoming fund raiser, WQG members donated 37 blue and white Ohio Star blocks that made a 69" X 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt. At the August meeting, the quilt was presented by Daleen Dotson, Fun with Fabric Committee, to Adam Williams, Director of Outreach for the Fallen Fifteen. The quilt will be auctioned at a benefit gala planned for the Columbus Zoo.
