Comfort Quilt Happenings

Westerville Quilt Guild members can be proud of the ways they help others through participation in the Community Comfort Quilt project. This is the third year for the service project to meet the needs in the Westerville community by providing crib quilts to Project AWARE (All Westerville Area Residents Enriched). This organization operates as a Westerville Outreach to families in need and names come from the Westerville Caring and Sharing program and the school district.

Once again members will be given fabric to make a Baby Comfort Quilt during the year. This year we would challenge members to use that fabric in the quilt as well as incorporating a star in some way into your creation. This could be using any of numerous star pieced patterns, an appliqué with a star, or simply using a star in the corner of the quilt. The fabric will be made available to members at the February 27 meeting and the quilts will be due at the September meeting.

A Comfort Quilt Workday was held on February 10 and several Rail Fence pattern quilt tops were completed during the day. In addition to good company and good snacks, we stayed busy with cutting, ironing, sewing and assembling the quilt tops - adding batting, backing and binding to a kit for some to take home. We will have some additional completed tops for members to take home as well as some cut strips with directions for others to take home to assemble and quilt.

"The Art of Quilting" On PBS March 2007

See inspiring quilt artists at work in their studios. Discover how the boundaries of traditional American quilt making have expanded to an art form that now adorns the walls of exhibit halls and art galleries worldwide. **The Art of Quilting** honors America's contemporary art quilters by visiting art quilt exhibitions across the country and through personal interviews with nationally and internationally noted fabric artists.

The program highlights the quilts and artists of Quilt National - a bienniel show held for nearly 30 years at the Dairy Barn in Athens, Ohio - the premier exhibition of contemporary art quilts in the country. **The Art of Quilt-ing** is made possible by the Alberta Kimball Foundation and by contributions to PBS stations from viewers.
