Rule Review:

1. Bring one 6" square of pre-washed fabric for each person in your group, including yourself.
2. Please only quilt shop fabric and make sure all selvages are removed.
3. Put squares in Ziploc bag with your name on bag.

Ohio State Fair Information

Everyone should consider entering a quilt or quilted item in the Ohio State Fair. Entry fees are minimal and ribbon winners get modest dollar awards along with the ribbon. Be sure to enter your quilt in the correct category or it will be disqualified. Read the information carefully. Here's the web site: <http://www.ohioexpoenter.com/osf/osf.php> where you'll be able to download general information for the family arts and crafts division, the entry form, needlework & sewing guidelines/entry classes, and the schedule. Entry form deadline is June 20, 2008. Delivery dates are July 19-20, 2008. Your entry will be judged and you'll get an evaluation sheet with things you do well (and they always give you some "well comments") and things they'd recommend you work on improving. It's fun to have your friends come up and say they saw your quilt at the fair!
