

A BIG Success!

Thanks to all of you for your hard work and for displaying your quilts — that's what made our first quilt show a big success. The team who helped on Saturday did a beautiful job setting up the show while I was busy flying back from Alaska. I'm so proud of all of you!

Who won the ribbons, you're wondering? Well, come to the September meeting to find out. Since we didn't get the count done in time to award the ribbons before the show came down (our original plan), we've decided to make a big show of it at the meeting on Sept. 23. After the meeting we'll post the information on the web site.

We had 277 adults and 43 children vote for their favorites. We think perhaps 75% or less actually voted, so we think we had over 400 viewer's of our beautiful quilts.

We also managed to make a small amount of money on the show. We spent \$70.12 and took in \$100.00 for our little ornaments for a profit of \$29.88. We did that by borrowing quilt racks from Sunbury Guild and signs from Columbus Metropolitan Quilters and having Trish

Rule Review:

1. Bring one 6" square of pre-washed fabric for each person in your group, including yourself.
2. Please only quilt shop fabric and make sure all selvages are removed.
3. Put squares in Ziploc bag with your name on bag.
