January 25, 2011 Edie Craig & Maralina Patton Presidents-of-the-Month Leslie Floyd Historic Ohio Quilting



Leslie Floyd will present *Two-Hundred Years of Ohio Quilting: Quilts from the Ohio Historical Society Collection*. She will be showing through computer slide presentation about 25 quilts from their collection and sharing each one's history. Leslie would be glad to talk with anyone about their old quilts.

Leslie's bio:

"I am retired from the Ohio Historical Society where I was Curator of History. I specialized in political, fraternal and commemorative memorabilia and historic money and most recently curator of the quilt and coverlet collection. I curated several exhibits focusing on Ohio's history, both military and domestic. I have a BS.Education and a Master's in History from OSU. My thesis was on women's business organizations in Ohio from 1900 to 1945.

I began quilting in 1992. I enjoy hand quilting but don't often find the time to do it. Most of my quilts are traditional/contemporary and contrary to belief, I'm not that wild about most reproduction fabrics. I like to mix it up!

I volunteer for the National Quilting Association (NQA) as their on-site quilt coordinator - managing the delivery, take-down and repacking of the quilts entered in the show. Any volunteer would be welcome."

We will have signup sheets at the January meeting, so get ready for Fun with Fabrics.
