Enjoy an evening with the very talented Jean Weissman presenting mixed media quilts and surface design! Jean will show us an array of her many eclectic art quilts and then how she transfers that talent into creating her designs!

Watch and observe how she will show 1 design and by using her experience of

mixed media and surface design will then create 3 completely different looks in her art quilts!!

After all this...sit back and enjoy a presentation on machine felting. Jean will bring her felting sewing machine and with the beauty of technology, you will get to watch up close how to machine felt on fabric *and* paper! The possibilities are endless! See her greeting cards, hand painted scarves and more.

Jean Weissman, born in Germany and raised in Chicago, has lived most of her adult life in Ohio. She studied art and home economics at the University of Maryland and received a Masters Degree in Social Work at the Ohio State University.

After retiring as a psychiatric social worker for 22 years, Jean was able to devote her full attention to her passion of bringing artistic inspirations to life. A student of surface design for many years, Jean is equally at home with oils, acrylics and watercolors,

Here are the details: Squares are 6 x 6 of quilt shop quality fabric. Drop off current month, pick up last month... etc. Each month represents a topic or color. There are usually about 8-10 people in a swap, so you only bring squares for the number in your group.

January - Snow/Winter (Whites)

February - Valentine's Day (Reds)

March- St Patrick's Day (Greens)

April- Flowers (your choice)

May- Mother's Day (Pinks)

June- Water/Lake/Ocean (Blues)

July-Patriotic (Red/White/Blue)

August- Picnics (your choice)

September- School Days/Sports (your choice)

October- Halloween (Oranges)

November - Thanksgiving (Browns)

December - Holiday cheer (your choice)

Because there will not be a December meeting, please bring December fabric in November. It really is a fun way to add to your stash.
